What is Solution Initiative Forum (SIF)?

What is SIF Oceans?

SIF Oceans is the first edition of SIF and it provides an interactive meeting arena to identify and promote available solutions from Northern Europe focusing on four challenges:

- Marine litter solutions focusing on collecting, recycling and replacing plastic.
- Smart and Clean Energy for All

 solutions focusing on marine renewable energy such as sea current, wave and tidal energies, as well as reducing greenhouse emissions from shipping.
- Finding sustainable protein sources solutions focusing on production of marine food for humans and livestock.
- Marine pollution solutions focusing on reducing emissions of environmental pollutants.

Solutions have been selected based on six eligibility criteria. The solutions should:

- **1. Be linked** to one (or more) of the four challenges at SIF Oceans.
- 2. All together they should highlight a broad range of examples of innovative solutions from Northern Europe. The aim is not to be comprehensive but rather to reflect the broad range of solutions that are available
- 3. Be readily available and have overcome initial barriers.
- Be transformative: the solutions should have the potential to move the society towards sustainability.
- **5. Be holistic:** the solutions should take all the SDGs into consideration in a SDG Impact Assessment.
- **6. Be scalable:** the solutions and the company must have the potential to perform well after expanding in scope, size and/or geographically.

Self-evaluation through the SDG Impact Assessment

Each company presented in the Ocean Solutions Report and at SIF Oceans undertake a self-evaluation of its solution through an SDG Impact Assessment, highlighting the potential impact that the solution has on the SDGs. To make the self-evaluation a learning process, solutions receive comments from an Advisory Panel.
